4.1. CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES

Closing date for entries: 03-06-2024 (Monday) 17:00.

Closing date for entries with increased fee: 07-06-2024 (Friday) 17:00.

In case if the maximum number of participants (100) will be reached, does not apply or will be stopped earlier.

4.2. ENTRY PROCEDURE

Competitors must fill online entry form, published www.autorally.lt till the terms set in art 4.1 of these Regulations. Entry form is considered accepted only when it is completely filled out and when the entry fee is paid in full. Co-driver details may be specified during Administrative Checking. The original signed entry form must be submitted during the administrative check.

4.3. NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS AND CLASSIFICATIONS

- 4.3.1. Total maximum number of the crews 100. The right of priority will be given to the crews participating in the LARC and LARSC rounds, who submitted their entry forms and paid entry fee on time. Number of participants in Shakedown is limited to 40 crews.
- 4.3.2. The cars eligible to enter the event. The cars complying with the Article 4.1-4.2 of 2024 LARC Regulations requirements are allowed to participate in LARC 2nd round classifications. The cars complying with the Article 4.1-4.2 of 2024 LARSC Regulations requirements are allowed to participate in LARSC 3rd round classifications. The cars complying with 2024 FIA Technical Regulations are allowed to participate in "Rally Žemaitija 2024" overall classification.

- To candidates whose entry has not been accept– 100%;
- In case of the rally does not take place due to force majeure 50 %;
- If the crew is unable to take part for serious reasons recognized by the Organizer 50%.

V. INSURANCE

5.1. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE ORGANIZER:

- 5.1.1. Organizer's Liability Insurance. Organizer insures the participants of the competition with civil liability insurance, while they drive in all speed stages, incl. "Shakedown", from the start to the finish or till the moment if the crew retired or is exlused from the Rally.
- 5.1.2. Damage caused to the Third Party. Insurance contract is coverage for damages caused to the third party, however, damages caused by drivers among themselves are not covered by contract.
- 5.1.3. International green card. All crews must have valid motor liability insurance or an international green card. Without valid insurance the crew will not be allowed to start.

5.2. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR COMPETITORS AND CREWS:

All drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own life accident insurance. Signing entry form, drivers and entrants relinquish any claims to compensation of any kind which might result due to accidents. The relinquishment is applied to FIA, LASF and Organizer, Rally officials and other entrants and drivers.

Drivers and co-drivers from non-EU countries must have valid travel insurance covering active recreational risk.

5.3. DAMAGE REPORTING

Crews are obliged to notify Organizer about any damage caused on the track by their car by the end of event the latest. Failure to do it so may inflict 100 EUR penalty.

5.4. DAMAGE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

Organizer is not responsible for any damage caused by the participants, if it occurred in breach of the Rally Rules, Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations or legal acts of the Republic of Lithuania. According to the insurance contract, all support cars (Reconnaissance, Service and other cars with stickers issued by the Organizer) are not insured and drive everywhere at their own risk. In case of a traffic accident only their own third-party liability insurance is valid.

VI. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Prior to the pre-start Scrutineering starting numbers, rally stickers and Organizer's advertising should be affixed on the rally car according to Appendix 4.

6.2. LOSS OR REMOVAL OF COMPETITION NUMERS AND ADVERTISING

Any failure with rules regarding start numbers and advertising will be reported to the Stewards.

VII. TYRES

7.1. NUMBER OF TYRES AND ELIGIBLE TYRES

7.1.1.Tires quantity. Limit of used tires for LARC competitors - 10. Maximum quantity of tyres for other participants is not limited. Tyres used during Test stage ("Shakedown") will not be counted towards the limited quantity.

7.1.2. Eligible tyres. During the rally are allowed only sports-type tires intended for gravel roads.

The crews participating in LARC must comply with requirements of Appendix 14 of 2024 LARC Regulations.

7.2. TYRES USED FOR RECONNAISSANCE

Only E- or DOT-approved road homologated tyres are allowed. During reconnaissance is forbidden use of retreated tyres with sport tread. Any treatment (removing or damaging) on road tyres side markings or texts is prohibited.

VIII. FUEL

8.1. USED FUEL

All crews are allowed to use commercial retail E85 fuel (bioethanol).

8.2. REFUELING:

- 8.2.1. Refueling for all participants is allowed only in refueling zones (RZ). Refuel zone marked in the Road book will be located after exit from Service zone in Kelmė.
- 8.2.2. Remote refueling zones. Remote refueling zone will be available for all competitors after SS2.

Location: Kražiai, M. Valančiaus str. 59. Coordinates: 55.6040 22.6898.

8.2.3. Refueling procedure. Allowed to refuel the cars from barrels/canisters with fuel which available at commercial petrol stations. Only two team members with permissions can enter the refuel zone and perform the procedure. Only crew members and the support staff are responsible for complying with fire safety regulations during filling. A liquid-tight mat must be used. Refueling may be carried out in comply with T-2024 art.61.2. Non-compliance with rules will be penalized by decision of Stewards.

IX. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1. PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION

9.1.1. Reconnaissance registration will take place at the same time with administrative checks as follows:

13-06-2024 (Thursday)

17:00 – 18:00 for all crews, participating in Shakedown;

18:00 – 19:00 for LARC and overall rally standings crews, not participating in Shakedown.

14-06-2024 (Friday)

8:00 – 9:00 for LARSC crews, not participating in Shakedown.

9.1.2. Reconnaissance cars. Reconnaissance cars will be checked during reconnaissance. Reconnaissance cars must comply with Art.35.1 of T-2024. If for any reason the crew has to change the reconnaissance car, they must inform Rally secretariat (phone: +370-618-76683) about the data of the new reconnaissance car.

9.2. SPEED LIMITS:

9.2.1. In residential areas: 50 km/h

In non residential areas: Gravel roads: 70 km/h

Asphalt roads: 90 km/h Motorways: 120 km/h Highways: 130 km/h

9.2.2. Allowed speed during reconnaissance. During reconnaissance it is necessary to drive at a safe speed in accordance with the traffic laws of the Republic of Lithuania. The maximum permitted speed on Special stages during reconnaissance is 70 km/h, except in areas with road signs or other speed limits marked in the Road book. Breaches of traffic rules and speed limits on public roads also may be recorded by police officers and fined in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Lithuania. GPS data also will be tracked in the Road sections.

9.3. GPS SPEED CONTROL CHECKING DEVICES:

9.3.1. GPS speed control devices will be issued during the Administrative checking as follows:

13-06-2024 (Thursday)

17:00 – 18:00 for all crews, participating in Shakedown;

18:00 – 19:00 for LARC and overall rally standings crews, not participating in Shakedown.

14-06-2024 (Friday)

8:00 – 9:00 for LARSC crews, not participating in Shakedown. Place: Kelmė Culture centre, Vytauto Didžiojo str. 73, Kelmė. Coordinates: 55.6318 22.9359

9.3.2. Rally Safety Tracking system. Organizer provides all crews with a GPS tracking system, which must also be used during reconnaissance. Rally officials will track reconnaissance process by help of a GPS system. The evaluation of GPS data is the responsibility of the Clerck of the Course. If the car does not have a functioning GPS device during reconnaissance, Stewards will issue fines. After reconnaissance GPS device must be installed into the rally car.

9.3.3 Security and tracking principle. Each device has a unique serial number that is assigned to the each crew. During the rally, Headquarters keeps track of the location and speed of each crew. The GPS tracking device is connected to a monitoring center where all incoming data is stored. All data is also stored on the device itself. The device has an autonomous voltage source that works during the entire rally. The device has SOS and OK buttons. By

pressing the "SOS" button, crew members report an accident and request emergency assistance. In this case, it is necessary to report about accident to the phone number indicated on the sticker of the GPS device. If the car has stopped due to an accident or technical problems on the speedway for more than 30 seconds, but emergency assistance is not required, by pressing the "OK" button, the crew members inform Rally Headquarters that the car has stopped and that assistance is not required.

Attention! If the crew has stopped in the speed stage for a period longer than 30 seconds, even in case if the crew tries to continue the race, it is necessary to send an "OK" message. The crew's mobile phones must be switched on (or switched on within 60 seconds) so that the Rally HQ can inquire about the current situation. If the crew receives an electronic red flag alarm (an audible signal and the yellow light switches), the OK button must be held down for 1 second to acknowledge receipt of the message to the Rally control centre. The crew must immediately reduce speed and follow the marshals' instructions. Failure to comply with these requirements will be penalized by decision of Stewards.

9.3.4. Returning of GPS devices. After the finish of the rally (TC 11B), GPS device must be removed from the rally car and returned to officials in Park Ferme. Did not finished rally crews must deliver the device to Rally HQ till 15-06-2024 (Saturday) 20:30.

9.4. RECONNAISSANCE TIME SCHEDULE

Reconnaissance time schedule is published in Appendix 2.

9.5. RECONNAISSANCE RULES

Reconnaissance will be organized in compliance with Art.35 of T-2024 and these Supplementary Regulations. *Driving in the speed stages in the opposite direction is strictly prohibited*, except cases specified in art. 9.5.4.

- 9.5.1. After publication of the Supplemmentary Regulations, any Driver or Co-driver, or any other member of Entrant's team, who participates in LARC, LARSC or intends to participate only in the rally "Rally Žemaitija 2024" and wants to drive/cross the roads belonging to the "Restricted roads areas" (Appendix 5), must obtain the Organizer's permission. This rule does not apply to persons living in restricted road areas. The Stewards and the national ASN will be informed about all recorded violations.
- 9.5.2. Number of persons on board. During reconnaissance maximum 2 persons are permitted in the car. 3rd person in the car during reconnaissance may be only with the permit from the Clerk of the Course and must have a valid license issued by LASF or other ASN.
- 9.5.3. Number of passages. Maximum 2 passages over each Special stage is permitted during reconnaissance. Identically repeated special stage is counted as one stage.
- 9.5.4. Exceptions to reconnaissance restrictions:

Section from SS6 and SS8/10 start to 1.48 km point, although is identical, is treated as different stages and is therefore allowed to be passed 4 times.

SS9 section from 2.06 km to 3.01 km is allowed to be passed 2 times in opposite direction and 2 times in SS direction. See Appendix 7, which will be published 10-06-2024.

9.5.5. Speeding. Exceeding speed during reconnaissance will be penalized in accordance with T-2024 Art. 34.2.2.

X. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1. PROVIDED INFORMATION:

10.1.1. Sportsmen who have licenses issued by LASF must provide valid data of Driver and Co-driver of E-LASF mobile application, also addition of fully information in the entry form (if it necessary).

10.1.2. Sportsmen who have licenses issued by ASN of another country must submit following documents:

Driver and Co-driver competitors licences;

Driver and Co-driver driving licences;

ASN authorisation, when it's applicable;

Addition of fully information in the entry form (if it necessary);

Medical certificate of aptitude F 068/a or "Medical certificate of aptitude" FIA appendix L, cause 1.8; Drivers and co-drivers from non-EU countries - valid travel insurance covering active recreational risk.

11.2. LOCATION AND SCHEDULE

The exact schedule will be published <u>www.autorally.lt</u> and Sportity app. The crew or the crew representative must attend to the Srutineering and present the car for inspection at the appointed time. Delays will be fined 30 EUR for every 10 minutes delayed. 1st and 2nd drivers are not required to take part in the Scrutineering.

11.3. MUDGUARDS

Transversal mudguards are not mandatory.

11.4. WINDOWS

The use of silvered or tinted films is authorized on side windows and rear windows only (in conformity with FIA Appendix J art. 253-11).

11.5. DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT

During Scrutineering all items of protective clothing are going to be checked, including underwear, helmets and FIA approved head restraint (FHR). Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked.

11.6. NOISE LEVEL

The maximum noise level must not exceed 103 dB for an engine rotation speed of 3500 rpm.

11.7. INSTALATION OF SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

- 11.7.1. All crews must arrange for the installation of a GPS tracking device in the car. During administrative checking, GPS devices will be issued to each crew and all necessary information will be provided.
- 11.7.2. The GPS tracking device must be placed in the recce car before starting to reconnaissance. GPS device must be transferred to the sports car and submitted for inspection in front of TC 0 area.
- 11.7.3. Any attempts of the crew to suppress or affect the signals or operation of GPS device during reconnaissance and/or during the race will be reported to the Stewards, who will impose fines or decide to disqualify the crew.

XII. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1. RALLY OPENING PROCEDURE

The sports part of the Rally begins from TCO. The crews will start from Service zone following the published start list and drive through the starting arch (TCO). Start interval between the crews - 1 min.

12.2. FINISH PROCEDURE

After the last stage, the crews must drive through the rally finish arch (TC11A) into the Park Ferme on Vytauto Didžiojo street, Kelmė. TC11B is considered as the finish of the rally. In the Park Ferme, the GPS tracking device must be removed from the sports car and returned. Finally scrutineering, can be carried out in the Park Ferme, or the cars, accompanied by officials, will be delivered for technical inspection to "Mano garažas", Uosių str. 122, Pagojis, Kelmės district, coordinates: 55.6099, 22.9006. The procedure will be carried out after the finish podium.

The cars may be taken from Park Ferme only with Steward's permission. If the competition does not deviate from the planned schedule, Park Ferme will be opened at 21:20.

12.3. CHECKING PROCEDURES

12.3.1. Early check-in without time penalty is allowed:

TC 2A (entering to Regroup area);

TC 5A (entering to overnight PF);

TC 7A (entering to the Service);

TC 7B (exit from the Service);

TC 7C (entering to Regroup area);

TC 11A (Finish podium);

TC 11B (entering to finish PF).

12.4. START PROCEDURE IN SPECIAL STAGES

Start procedure in Special stages will be perform as follows:

At the starting point, the crew must stop following the marshals' instructions;

- When the start marshal confirms that the car is on the right start position 50 cm before electronically controlled start line, the car must stay immovable till start moment and the crew must visually follow the time and lights on the monitor:
- 30 seconds before the start marshal hands the time card to the Co-driver;
- The last five seconds are marked by 5 red lights and a green light. The first red light lights up on 55th second, second on 56th second and so on. On the time of exact minute red light go out and green light lights up.
- If the car crosses the beam before the green light lights up "FALSE" will be shown automatically on the monitor. False-start will be penalized according T-2024 Art.48.6.
- Final decision for the false start is made by the start marshal, who notes about it in the start protocol;
- In case of start system failure, the start procedure will be carried out in accordance with T-2024 Art.48.3.

Retired crews must return it's time cards either at the nearest control post or to the "Sweepper" car marshals.

12.6. OFFICIAL TIME USED DURING THE RALLY

During the rally official time is considered the Eastern European summer time (CET +2, UTC+3).

12.7. REGROUPINGS

12.7.1. The following regroups will be carried out for the crews of LARC and rally overall classifications:

12.7.1.1 With start positions' change – TC 2A according SS 1-2 results (new start time TC 2B);

TC 5A according SS 1-5 results (new start time TC 5B);

TC 7C according SS 1-7 results (new start time TC 7D);

12.7.1.2 Without start positions' change – TC 4A (new start time TC 4B);

TC 9A (new start time TC 9B).

- 12.7.2 The following regroups will be carried out for the crews of LARSC classifications:
- 12.7.2.1 With start positions' change TC 7C according SS 6-7 results (new start time TC 7D);
- 12.7.2.2 Without start positions' change TC 9A (new start time TC 9B).

12.8. RETIRING DUE TO ACCIDENT

The crews retired after an accident, must submit their cars to the Chief Scrutineer for inspection of damage. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in a fine of EUR 150. The crews participating in LARC or LARSC, no later than 1 working day must present the car for LASF technical inspection.

12.9. RE- START / RALLY 2

- 12.9.1. Re-start after the retirement (Rally 2) for LARC and overall rally classification crews is possible TC 5B in accordance with 2024 LARC Regulations Art. 7.6 requirements.
- 12.9.2. Re-start after the retirement (Rally 2) for LARSC crews is possible TC 7D in accordance with 2024 LARSC Regulations Art. 7.6 requirements.

Service zone A/B/C/D is located in Kelmė, in the section of Vytauto Didžiojo street from M. Valančiaus street till Laisvės Gynėjų Square. Entry coordinates: 55.6336 22.9425, exit coordinates 55.6304, 22.9338. Surface coating: asphalt. Time: 14/06/2024 8:00 – 15/06/2024 20:00. Service regulations in accordance with T-2024. There will be no Remote Service zones during the rally.

12.10.1.Service places are allocated by the Organizer, in compliance with the information provided in entry form. The following areas will be reserved free of charge for each participating car: for LARC 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 classifications – 80m²; for other LARC classifications – 70m²; for all LARSC classifications - 60m². The crews, in agreement with the Organizer, and payed additional fee of 15 EUR/m², can reserve places of larger area from 15-05-2024 (Wednesday). Acceptance of requests for larger service areas closes 03-06-2024 (Monday) at 17:00. After this deadline, the Organizer will assign service areas at it's discretion. In case the Entrant has several competing cars, which are serviced together in the Service zone, the request for connected service areas must be submitted via e-mail info@kelmesask.lt till 03-06-2024 (Monday) 17:00.

12.10.2. In Service zone all crews are obliged to have a liquid-proof tarp of minimum 3x5m under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service zone have to be avoided. Teams must have weights for fixing their tents. The Service zone must be left tidy after the rally. Crews are responsible for removing debris and liquids. Each Entrant must compensate the Organizer for the damage caused to the service location assigned to them and cover the costs of environmental management.

12.10.3. Only one service vehicle without trailer per one competitor is allowed enter to the Service zone. "Service" sticker issued by the Organizer must be affixed on the windscreen of Service vehicle. Recce cars and team representative vehicles are not allowed to enter to the Service zone. Please, leave Your trailers in Kelmė Sports centre parking lot, J.Janonio str. 11F, Kelmė, 55.6295 22.9208. The crews who fail to comply with Service rules will be fined.

12.11. SPEEDING AND OTHER ROAD TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS DURING THE RACE:

12.11.1. Exceeding speed during the race will be fined in accordance with T-2024 Art. 34.3.

If the rally car and/or service cars exceed the speed limit in the Service zone, a fine of EUR 25 will be imposed for each exceeded kilometer per hour (T-2024 Art.57.4).

12.11.2. Other Road Traffic breaches during the rally will be fined in accordance with T-2024 Art.34.4.

12.12. CHICANES

Chicanes will be set on Special stages for safety reasons, in order to reduce maximum speed. Where it is possible chicanes will be set before reconnaissance and will stay unhindered during whole rally. In places, where such action is impossible, the place of the chicane will be marked on the road surface.

The correct fact of passing the zone will be monitored by fact marshals, whose list will be published on the official board. Failure to overcome the chicane or overcoming it not according to the trajectory specified in the road book - a 20-second penalty. Pushing of retarders out of place/perimeter - 5 seconds penalty. A tolerance of 20 cm is applied.

12.13. TEST STAGE (SHAKEDOWN)

12.13.1. The crews wishing to take part in Shakedown must indicate it in entry form www.autorally.lt till 03-06-2024 (Monday) 17:00. The Test stage fee is 150 EUR, payable till 03-06-2024 (Monday) 17:00. After this term the fee will be increased to 200 EUR.

- 12.13.2. If the maximum number of participants (40 crews) will be reached, the registration can be stopped earlier. Entry fee may be refunded only due to "Force majeure" reasons.
- 12.13.3. Shakedown will be carried out on 14/06/2024 (Friday) from 11:00 till 13:00. The length of the stage is 3.63 km. Each crew is allowed to pass this section no more than 3 times. The cars participating in shakedown must undergo a pre-start scrutineering, start numbers, rally and advertising stickers must be affixed on the cars, and GPS tracking device must be installed in the car.
- 12.13.4 During the Test stage, any person who is not a participant of the rally but performing the duties of the second driver, must sign the consent form provided by the Organizer. During the Test stage, all persons in the car must wear safety helmets, clothing and other safety equipment.

- 14.1.2. 1st drivers who took I-III places in LARC 2nd round Junior standings are awarded with cups established by the Organizer.
- 14.1.3. The teams that took I-III places in LARC 2nd round "Team standings" are awarded cups established by the Organizer.

14.2. AWARDS OF THE 3rd ROUND OF LARSC

- 14.2.1. 1st and 2nd drivers who took I-III places in LARSC 3rd round SG2, SG3, SG4, AWD and 2WD classifications, are awarded with cups established by the Organizer.
- 14.2.2. 1st drivers who took I-III places in LARSC 3rd Junior standings are awarded with cups established by the Organizer.
- 14.2.3. The teams that took I-III places in LARSC 3rd round "Team standings" are awarded cups established by the Organizer.

14.3. "RALLY ŽEMAITIJA 2024" AWARDS

- 14.3.3 Special prizes. The list of special prizes, if they will be established, will be published by the Organizer's bulletin before the start of the rally.

14.4. AWARDING PROCEDURE

14.4.1. Awarding ceremony will take place on 15-06-2024 (Saturday) from 21:30 next to the Kelmė Culture center, Vytauto Didižiojo str.73, Kelmė. All awards and prizes to the crews will be presented on scene. If the award ceremony takes place before the announcement of the Official results, the ownership of the prizes awarded will be confirmed after announcement of the Official results.

- 14.4.2. 1st and 2nd drivers winners of I-III places in LARC 2nd round classifications during the awards ceremony must wear clothing as specified in Art. 11.1.3 of 2024 LARC Regulations.
- 14.4.3. 1st and 2nd drivers winners of I-III places in LARSC 3rd round classifications during the awards ceremony must wear clothing as specified in Art. 11.1.2 of 2024 LARSC Regulations.
- 14.5.4 Failure to comply with Art.14.4.2-14.4.3 requirements will be fined fines by decision of LASF Rally Committee. The crews who do not take part in awards will be fined and will lose their rights to the prizes.

XV. PROCEDURES AFTER FINISH

15.1. FINAL CHECKS

Place: "Mano garažas", Uosių str. 122, Pagojis, Kelmė distr. GPS: 55.6099, 22.9006

Date: 15-06-2024 (Saturday), just after finish of the rally.

15.1.1 The crews selected for Scrutineering after the finish by decision of the Stewards, or due to protest, must to provide for the necessary equipment, including all sealed spare parts and mechanics at the Scrutineering location. Selected car, with the escort of Rally Officials, must be driven away to the inspection site by a designated team member who must be ready at the finish point of the rally.

15.2. PROTESTS

- 15.2.1 Protests have to be lodged in accordance with LASC Art. 13.
- 15.2.2 The protest deposit is for LARC crews 150 EUR (LARC Regulations Art. 10.2), for LARSC crews 100 EUR (LARSC Regulations Art. 10.2). A document proving payment must be submitted together with the protest. The protest fee is paid to the Organizer. If the protest is satisfied, the deposit is returned. If the protest is not upheld, after the event deposit must be transferred to the LASF checking account.
- 15.2.3. If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of the car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit in accordance with LARC (LARSC) Regulations Art. 10.4.

15.3. APPEALS

Appeals have to be submitted in accordance with LASC Art. 15.

The sum for a national appeal deposit is EUR 1000.
