III. GENERAL CONDITIONS

3.1 Conducted event classifications

3.1.1 The 2024 Lithuanian Off-Road Championship classification is conducted in four classes: TR1, TR2, TR3, ADV.

3.1.2 ATV classes participate in the 2024 Lithuanian Off-Road Cup and the 2024 Latvian Can-am Trophy classification.

3.1.3 CT1 and CT2 classes participate in the 2024 Latvian Can-am Trophy classification.

3.3.1 The participant application form is published on the website www.lasf.lt and the 4x4 Lithuania Facebook group www.raceadmin.eu.

3.3.2 Upon correctly filling out the application, the participant receives confirmation that their application has been accepted.

3.3.3 All participants with valid LASF "C" or "CI" category or other FIA ASF (members) issued driving licenses, valid sports insurance during the competition, may participate in the 2024 Lithuanian Off-Road Championship. All crew members must have licenses.

3.3.4 During the administrative commission, participants can purchase single-use licenses. The cost of a single-use "B" license is 30 Euros, and a single-use "C" license is 10 Euros. For insurance, please contact via email lasf@lasf.lt

3.3.5 The organizer has the right to partially or fully exempt the participant from paying the entry fee.

3.3.6 By signing the application, the participant and their team commit to comply with the requirements of the documents regulated by LASF as specified in point 2.1.

3.3.7 By signing the application, the participant and the applicant agree that the highest and final instance resolving disputes in motor sport is the LASF Appeal Court.

3.5 Insurance

The organizer guarantees civil liability insurance during the event. The event is insured with event organizer civil liability insurance with a total insurance amount of 6000 Euros based on LASVOVT appendix No. 3.

3.6 Participants' vehicles

Participation in the Lithuanian Off-Road Championship is allowed with vehicles that meet the 2024 Lithuanian Off-Road Championship Technical Requirements or the 2024 Latvian Can-Am Trophy CT1 and CT2 as well as ATV class requirements.

IV. INSPECTIONS

4.1 Document inspection

4.1.1 Participants must personally arrive for document inspection at the secretariat at the time and place specified in the program.

4.1.2 During the inspection, the following must be presented: the original participant-signed application with necessary signatures, sports license, sports insurance, and the vehicle's sports technical passport if the vehicle has one. Also, other mandatory documents specified in the supplementary regulations.

4.1.3 Except for cases known to the event director, participants who do not arrive for document inspection at the scheduled time will not be allowed to participate in the competition.

4.1.4 Participants must have valid driver's licenses not lower than LASF "C" or "CI" category or equivalent FIA ASF (members) issued licenses. All crew members must have valid licenses and sports insurance during the competition.

4.2 Technical Inspection

4.2.1 Vehicles arriving for technical inspection must meet the technical requirements of the 2024 championship and must be presented at the time specified in these regulations.

4.2.2 Any vehicle presented for technical inspection must be in a race-ready condition, with all safety and auxiliary equipment securely fastened.

4.2.3 Tire pressure must be set at 0.5 BAR.

4.2.4 If a participant is late for the technical commission, the technical commissioner must be personally informed in advance by phone.

4.2.5 The participant must present valid vehicle registration documents and insurance.

4.2.6 The participant must present a LASF vehicle technical passport or an equivalent FIA ASF (members) vehicle technical passport.

4.3 Crew Stickers and Board Numbers

4.3.1 Mandatory advertising stickers are issued during the administrative commission.

4.3.2 Vehicles are presented for technical inspection with board numbers and mandatory advertising stickers attached.

4.3.3 Stickers must be applied to the vehicle. If additional advertising stickers or board numbers are not attached to the vehicle, the crew will not be allowed to start, and the entry fee will not be refunded.

4.3.4 Crews must take care of their own board numbers, except for the ADV class, for which the organizers will provide stickers during the administrative commission.

4.3.5 ATV class participants must wear a reflective vest with their participant board number on the back and chest. If participants have received such vests in previous competitions, they must provide their own vests. If you change the class in which you participate during the championship, you must inform about this additionally during the registration/administrative commission. If a crew is participating in the Can-am Trophy series competition for the first time in the 2024 season, the organizer will issue vests during the administrative commission and provide the crew with a board number. The board number can also be indicated on the quad bike, but the vest is mandatory. If the participant's vest is unsuitable for use and it has already been issued before, the participant will be provided with a new one during the administrative commission for a fee of 15 Euros, and in such a case, the participant's board number will also change.

4.3.6 Crew numbers cannot be duplicated; participants are requested to ensure during registration that their number does not duplicate existing ones on the list. This can be checked at: <https://www.lasf.lt/lt/4x4/reglamentai/>, by viewing the appendix: " Borto numeriu registras 2024m ".

V. EVENT CONDUCT

5.1 Crew requirements

5.1.1 Crew safety and equipment check is performed during the technical commission.

5.1.2 When driving on public roads, crews must comply with Lithuanian road traffic rules unless otherwise specified in the supplementary regulations.

5.1.3 At the start and finish, the entire crew must be in the vehicle. If not all crew members are in the vehicle, the result will not be included in the protocol.

5.1.4 During the event, crew members must be sober and not under the influence of other intoxicating substances as required by Lithuanian road traffic rules. If there is suspicion that a crew member is intoxicated, the sports commissioner or the chief event doctor may check their sobriety with a breathalyzer. If intoxication is determined or the driver refuses to be tested, the sports commissioners may prohibit the crew from continuing the event. In such cases, the entry fee is not refunded, and the participant's behavior is referred to the LASF Disciplinary and Ethics Commission.

5.1.5 By submitting an application to participate in the event or signing during the administrative commission, the participant signs the 2024 Participant Commitment Document, otherwise, the crew will not be allowed to participate in the event.

5.2 Event conduct

5.2.1 Official event time is local time according to GPS.

5.2.2 All changes and additions, as well as important information related to the event, will be published on the official event board with bulletins confirmed by the Event Director or Commissioner and/or the SPORTITY app.

5.2.3 Crews withdrawing from the event must inform the organizers about the withdrawal reasons, location, and time by calling the secretariat at the specified phone number +370 699 41690.

5.2.4 Underneath the sports car or ATV during repair, a waterproof and oil-resistant mat (minimum size 4m x 4m) must be placed. At the refueling site, beneath the fuel tank filling cap, a gasoline-resistant film (minimum size 1m x 1m) must also be placed, and a container for spilled fuel must be provided. A fine of 50 Euros for each such case is payable at the event secretariat. Without paying the fine, the crew is not allowed to start.

5.3 EVENT STAGES

The event consists of the following stages (for TR1, TR2, TR3 classes):

- Prologue (coefficient 0.3) – TR1, TR2, TR3 classes

Saturday:

- Orientation:
 - OR1 (coefficient 1.0) – TR1, TR2, TR3 classes (Virtual points)
 - OR2 (coefficient 2.0) – TR1, TR2, TR3 classes (Photo points)
 - OR3 (coefficient 1.2) – TR1, TR2, TR3 classes (Night section)
- Mud Lap:
 - SR1 (coefficient 1.0) – TR1, TR2, TR3 classes (Mud Lap)

- Special Stage:
 - SS1 (coefficient 0.3) – TR1, TR2, TR3 classes (Special section during daytime OR)

Sunday:

- Mud Lap:
 - SR2 (coefficient 1.0) – TR1, TR2, TR3 classes (Mud Lap)

The event consists of the following stages (for all ATV classes):

Saturday:

- Mud Lap:
 - SR1 ATV (coefficient 1.0) – All ATV classes
 - SR2 ATV (coefficient 1.0) – All ATV classes

The event consists of the following stages (for ADV class):

Saturday:

 - OR ADV (coefficient 1.0) – ADV class

Sunday:

- Mud Lap:
 - SR ADV (coefficient 1.0) – ADV class

The event consists of the following stages (for CT1, CT2 class):

Saturday:

 - SR1 CT1, CT2 (coefficient 1.0) – CT1, CT2 classes

 - SR2 CT1, CT2 (coefficient 1.0) – CT1, CT2 classes

5.4 Additional Information

5.4.1 The starting order for the prologue will be determined by drawing lots.

5.4.2 The starting order for OR1 will be determined by the prologue results.

5.4.3 The starting order for OR3 (night section) will be determined by the SR1 results.

5.4.4 OR2 control points must be captured in photographs where one crew member is seen next to the vehicle number or registration number, ensuring clear visibility. During the photo, one hand of the crew member must touch the control point, and the other hand must touch an integral part of the vehicle.

5.4.5 Photos must be submitted within 30 minutes after the finish to the orientation section finish marshal.

5.4.6 SS1 will take place within the OR1/OR2 time norm.

5.5 MINIMUM EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

5.5.1 Sufficient food and drinking water for each crew member for at least 10 hours.

5.5.2 Suitable clothing for the existing weather conditions.

5.5.3 Digital camera or smartphone with a memory card capable of taking photos. Android or IOS device with internet connection and GPS receiver with pre-installed navigation application (e.g., Locus Map, OSM, Oziexplorer). It is recommended to use a suitable navigation laptop/tablet with Windows operating system and Oziexplorer or Zinc navigation programs.

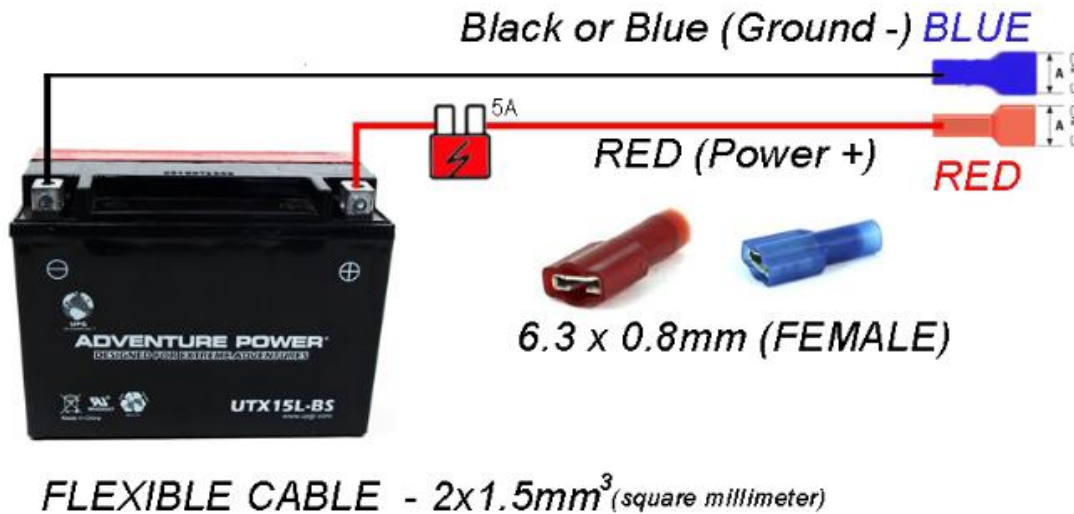
5.5.4 Each team member must wear a yellow vest with reflectors during the race. Each team member must wear a helmet that meets the class's technical regulations.

5.5.5 Participants can obtain the coordinates of orientation sections' points in two ways:

5.5.5.1 By the documentation provided by the organizational team or the event board/SPORTITY app (password: LPC4) or any alternative reference provided by the organizational team on the race day.

5.5.5.2 By presenting a USB drive during registration to write the coordinates electronically. The drive must not contain any other data. Note that alternative information media such as GPS devices and computers will not be accepted.

5.6 Additional GPS Tracking Technical Requirements

5.6.2 If a "Kill Switch" system is installed in the vehicle, it must not disconnect the GPS tracking system from the power source (battery) when used.

5.6.3 Participants must have pre-wired cables for the GPS tracking system before the technical inspection, according to the specified Example No. 1.

5.6.4 TR1/TR2/TR3/ADV class participants will not have their technical compliance confirmed if the participant has not pre-wired the power cables according to the specified example No. 1.

5.6.5 The pre-wired power cables must have connectors (switches) specified in Example No. 1 - 6.3 x 0.8mm.

5.6.6 The length of the pre-wired cable for TR1/TR2/TR3/ADV classes must be at least 50cm. The cable must be routed to the central panel area.

5.6.7 The positive terminal cable must have a 5A fuse installed/connected.

5.6.8 100 EURO deposit will be required for the GPS equipment, which will be taken when it is installed and returned after the race. If the equipment is not returned or is damaged during the race, the deposit will not be refunded.

IMPORTANT:

Each participant must ensure the technical condition of the electrical system and the battery charging system.

If it is found that the GPS tracking system was not working due to a fault in the vehicle's electrical system or it was mechanically damaged, the racer's result may not be counted.

VI. PENALTIES

6.1 All violations and penalty amounts are specified in the 2024 Lithuanian 4x4 Off-Road Championship and Cup regulations and rules Appendix No. 2.

6.2 Speed is limited to 30 km/h on all transfers on public roads. Speed tolerance is 0 km/h. Exceeding the speed up to 10 seconds results in a warning. The excess speed time is summed, and the penalty is 5 sec. = 50 Euros. This additional penalty is payable to the event organizer at the event secretariat. Take note this is additional penalty to the regulations and rules stated in Appendix No. 2. If the fine is not paid, the crew is not allowed to continue the event. Refusing to pay this fine will result in the crew's disqualification from the event.

6.3 Organizers and official event personnel are not responsible for uploading points to any participant's device. Such action is strictly prohibited and incurs a 50 Euro fine payable to the event organizer by both the event participant and the official event personnel.

VII. RESULTS. PROTESTS. APPEALS

7.1 Results

7.1.1 Results for TR1, TR2, TR3, ADV classes are calculated according to the 2024 Lithuanian Off-Road Championship result calculation table (Appendix No. 3).

7.1.2 Results for CT1, CT2 classes are calculated according to the Can-Am trophy rules (LAF). <https://trofi.lv/wp-content/uploads/2022/12/LTC-Gada-Nolikuma-Pielikums-Nr.1-punkti.pdf>

7.1.3 Results for ATV classes are calculated according to the Can-Am trophy rules (LAF). <https://trofi.lv/wp-content/uploads/2022/12/LTC-Gada-Nolikuma-Pielikums-Nr.1-punkti.pdf>

7.1.4 The lap time is recorded manually or electronically at the discretion of the organizer.

7.1.5 The lap time is recorded in hh:mm:ss format unless otherwise specified.

7.2 Protests

7.2.1 Protests are submitted in accordance with the requirements of Article 13 of the LASK.

7.2.2 The protest submission time ends 30 minutes after the preliminary results are announced.

7.3 Appeals

7.3.1 Applicants have the right to submit an appeal as specified in Article 15 of the LASK.

VIII. PRIZES

8.1 Crews that win first, second, and third places in the classes are awarded diplomas, trophies, and sponsors' prizes, if any, by the Organizer.

IX. OTHER INFORMATION

9.1 TR1, TR2, TR3 class crews participate in the 2024 Lithuanian Off-Road Championship classification.

9.2 CT1, CT2 class crews participate in the 2024 LAF Can-Am Trophy Latvian Off-Road Cup classification.

9.3 ATV class crews participate in the 2024 Lithuanian Off-Road Cup classification and the Latvian Can-Am trophy cup classification.

9.4 Additional Information

9.4.1 The organizer provides a technical parking lot near the base area.
